Using listening skills and iconic notation, students will understand the connection between the sounds they hear and the techniques used to produce those sounds. Explicit instruction in proper hand and mouth position and ear training as they relate to pitch and melodic direction. Students will have a performance opportunity at the end of the week. Materials fee of \$5 per student which includes both a harmonica and music book.
