Maggie’s workshops cover the 5 Cs (character, crime, conflict, conundrum and climax) of Mystery writing; Get Started (attitude, habits, location, tools, & atmosphere), Get organized (notebook & calendar) and Get Going (emotion, setting, who & how) on Memoir/Novel, and Plot your Novel in an Hour as well as lessons on Character and Setting. With a wealth of enthusiasm and a generous attitude toward people, she takes a hands-on approach for guided writing exercises.
