**Annie Fain Liden specializes in making and teaching how to make books from scratch. Her program can include either making an array of kid-friendly book structures (ranging from the simple pamphlet book to the more interactive origami fold star book) and/or visual journaling (this includes everything from guided prompts that combine writing and drawing to making pop-ups).**

**Annie Fain has a BA in Interdisciplinary Studies Appalachian Studies and Folklore, from UNC-Asheville. She studied at the Nordjylands Idraeshojkskole (Folkschool) in Bronderslev, Denmark, and has been along-time student of the John C. Campbell Folk School and Penland School of Crafts. Her areas of study have included photography, weaving, bookmaking, traditional dance, music, drawing, paper making and art history.**

**Annie Fain also completed a training program designed for art teachers to learn how to better combine art and science in the classroom. She has served as the coordinator of Little/Middle Folk School (craft/dance camp for kids) at John C. Campbell Folk School, in Brasstown, NC, and has taught dance for Cherokee County School System.**
