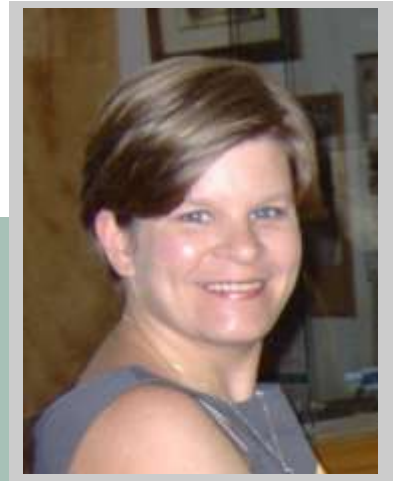


Tracie Peters Owenby
